Meeting opened with the Serenity Prayer at 5:45pm.

12 Concepts read by Charlotte.

This is a one-time format change to discuss the proposal brought forth by Megs and Melanie that on January 5, 2022 we separate the hybrid meeting into 2 separate meetings. An all in-person meeting and an online zoom meeting, keeping both under the Stepping Stones to Serenity group.

Some points/issues of concern from members who attended the meeting:

- 1. Be better at signing up for service positions. If separated will need 2 sets of service positions.
- 2. Newcomers prefer in-person rather than on-line.
- 3. Connectivity is lacking for some people with hybrid and zoom.
- 4. There isn't a newcomer greeter in person, so the newcomers are not getting that connection with group members because the in-person people are doing so much to get the meeting set-up that they are not able to give the proper welcome and chat to the newcomers.
- 5. Some on-line members have been with this group for many years and feel they will lose access to the meeting and having a voice at the business meetings.
- 6. Some expressed how much they liked interacting with people in person.
- 7. If you are able to go out and eat, travel and be around other people then why can't you make it 1 day a week to the meeting.
- 8. Zoom is convenient for those that work late or live far away.
- 9. Some were offended by saying people on zoom that don't show their faces aren't really there.
- 10. Some members feel the website is a concern and not comfortable signing up for chair spots and service positions.
- 11. Some have no choice but to stay home for health concerns or are living with someone with health issues.
- 12. Pause when making this decision while WSO and SRVAIS vote regarding online meetings no longer being a sanctioned meeting if not hybrid.
- 13. Suggested maybe waiting 3-6 months in case there is a spike in Covid cases during the cooler months.
- 14. If the group were divided, it would change the whole dynamics of the group itself.
- 15. Covid should definitely be of topic because this is the whole reason we started zoom to begin with.
- 16. Downscale the a/v components and have less of a great video experience.
- 17. There is no babysitter for in-person meeting.

- 18. Chairing is a problem and should not be pleaded to get filled.
- 19. If hybrid is continued, asking that the person chairing the meeting go in person
- 20. Need to work on getting the word out to people.
- 21. The "Owl microphone" was suggested.
- 22. Train more people, although the church may not all a lot of people to have access to their equipment.
- 23. Not enough people showing up in person to help with set-up because of vacant service positions. This leaves the in-person people to do all that is needed to run the hybrid meeting without the help from online members. IE: run a/v equipment, set-up and breakdown room, purchase literature.
- 24. Move from Hybrid to online only.
- 25. Speaker-hybrid meeting idea: 1 person shares, then in-person and on-line split up, all those that care to share will share and then all come back together to end meeting.
- 26. Cindi says the website is completely safe.
- 27. Need a task force to come up with a solution before next business meeting.

A motion was brought forth by Melanie to create a task force to address the issues/concerns and bring to the next business meeting. 2nd by Coey
